In addition to what has been sent from Inverness there were **58** boxes sent from Lewis by Airidhantuim Primary School in late December /early January with all transport costs fully paid. (See "Our School in Lewis" - click here: index.asp?pageid=265905).

In June 2011 a total of **40** banana boxes made up the latest consignment of clothing, food, soap, toothpaste and school resources for the three nursery schools we support in northern Malawi, not far from the city of Mzuzu. This represents a total of more than 100 children, and around 20-30 adults.



Once again the Trustees would like to take the opportunity to thank not only the individual men, women and children, who give so generously of their time, talent and money to help us, but also the several schools and the staff of Deloitte in Dubai

15 boxes went to what was originally known as "Our school" when Reay & Chrisanne came across it in July 2009, namely THANDAZGA nursery school.

16 boxes went to CHAMALAZA where the number of AIDS orphaned children has trebled in the past year.

9 boxes went to CHATATA, the third of the nursery schools supported by the Trust.

By 31 December 2011 a further 117 boxes were sent to the above bringing the total number of boxes sent for the year 2011 to 259 boxes. (IM 7.2.12)
